

Abstract. Robert Grosseteste commented early on the *Analytical Seconds*, constituting one of the initial cases of reception of the Aristotelian science theory in the Latinity. Two particularities are worth mentioning. First of all, it is one of the first comprehensive comments or step-by-step in Latin scholasticism. In addition, it is the only one in its time that orders the text based on conclusions or main theses of science, trying a systematic that arises from –and is guaranteed by– the original itself.

This paper is intended to be only an introduction to a topic that requires more complex analysis. A scheme of the source will be presented firstly. In the second part, the expository strategy of the Lincolnian will be exposed: 1. The use of step by step to fix text (including linguistic and semantic analysis), 2. A list of the main theses (conclusions) of the system, 3. His own progresses (hermeneutics and critics).
